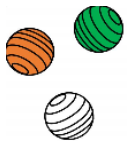

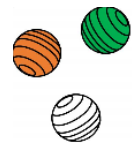

I am bringing my 8-year-old grandson this year to learn knot tying as he is taking sailing lessons. The Hapless Lexington lecture will recall the steamboat disaster that took place in 1840 right off our Huntington coast in Long Island Sound.

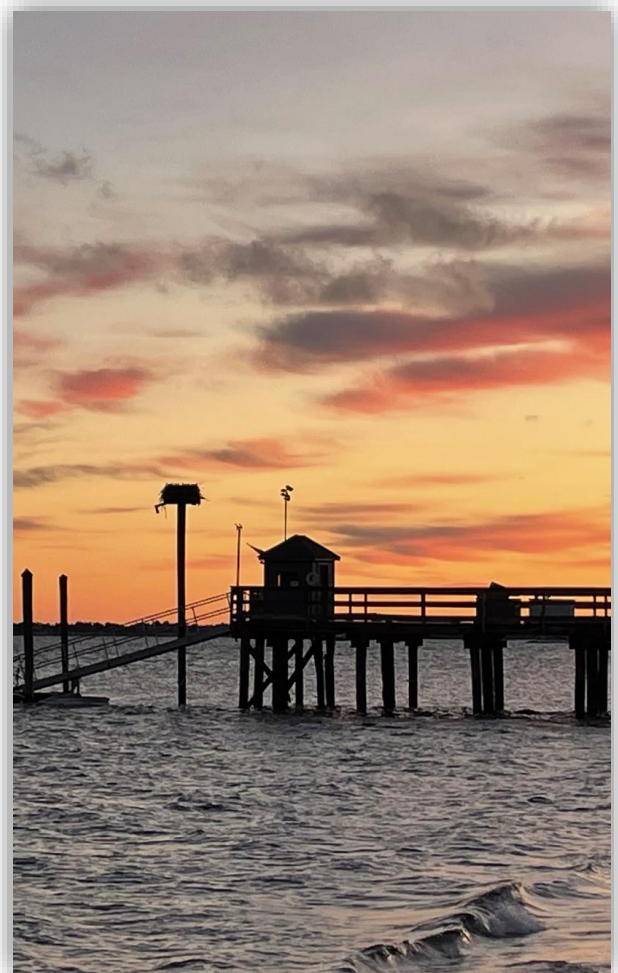
